Why this page does not look like an IRS letter

A real determination letter arrives on Internal Revenue Service letterhead with a seal and a signature. This sample deliberately reproduces none of those things. Imitating a government document convincingly is not something a demonstration site should do, even for a nonprofit that does not exist.

What is shown instead is the information such a letter carries, set in the organization's own typography.
